Companion Diocese Commission Report 2013-2014

The relationship between the Diocese of Georgia and the Dominican Republic is as strong as ever! We have been engaging in this relationship for almost two decades. As a result of our partnerships, many wonderful things have been shared between our two dioceses, which includes construction, Vacation Bible School, house construction, knitting classes, medical clinics, school scholarships, but most importantly, God's amazing love. Our diocese has sent youth teams, adult teams and a combination of both.

In the Diocese of Georgia, we are blessed with creative minds. Creativity has allowed us to approach mission in different ways. We have learned that partnerships between churches, convocations, and other dioceses are great ways to combine forces to accomplish the work God has given us to do. These partnerships make our teams stronger and allow us to combine our financial resources and to provide manual labor, which have allowed us to accomplish more difficult projects in the communities we are called to serve.

Once again, this year has proved to be a productive year of partnership with our Dominican brothers and sisters.
