

Meeting of Vestry

Christ Church Parish

November 4, 1937

The meeting was opened with prayer and was held in the Daniel Ashley Hotel.

It was agreed to change the meeting time from a regular specified time to call at the pleasure of the Rector or the Senior Warden.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Mr Caldwell and Mr Robinson reported that letters had been written as requested in the September 15th meeting.

Mr Mundy reported that Miss Bancroft will not have time to devote to the choir organization.

Mr Mundy also reported that vestments were now available for the lay-readers and that efforts were now in progress to vest the choir.

Mr Mundy stated that Bishop Barnwell would visit Valdosta on Tuesday November 16th.

Mr Caldwell suggested a spaghetti supper on that date at 7:30 P M, the cost to be met out of the parish treasury as the occasion will be used as the opening of the every-member canvass. Mr Caldwell and Mr Robinson were appointed a committee to handle the necessary details of arrangements.

It was stated that the Bishop desired the parish to set as an advance objective for the year, the assumption of \$100.00 more of the Rector's salary, thereby reducing the load on the Diocese. The ultimate objective will be the assumption of one half of the Rector's salary by Valdosta and Quitman. At the present time approximately one third of this item is being carried by the two missions.

Mr Caldwell reported on his and Mr Robinson's visit to the Layman's Conference held at Camp Reese on St Simon's Island.

Mr Robinson was selected as Chairman of the Every-Member Canvass.

A budget of \$781.00 was adopted for the year 1938 with the understanding that the \$100.00 item previously mentioned and included in this budget would be paid the diocese at the end of the year, finances permitting.

Arrangements will be made to invite and escort some of the college girls to the supper on November 16.

Mr Wilbur Loos was elected as Director of the Choir and Messrs Caldwell and McEachren were appointed a committee to advise Mr Loos of this action.

It was agreed that the Vestry would meet with the Bishop at 7 P M and before the supper on November 16.
